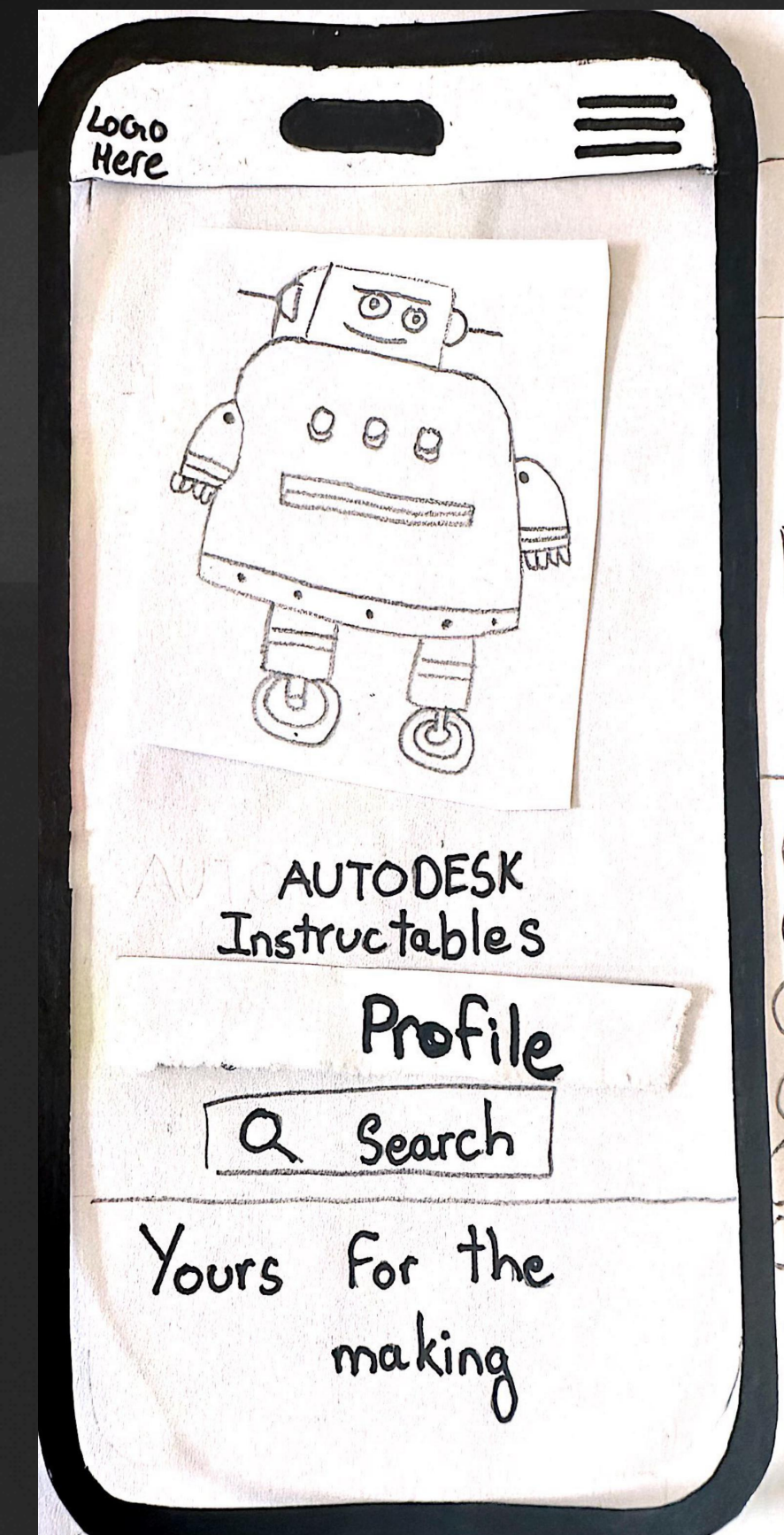
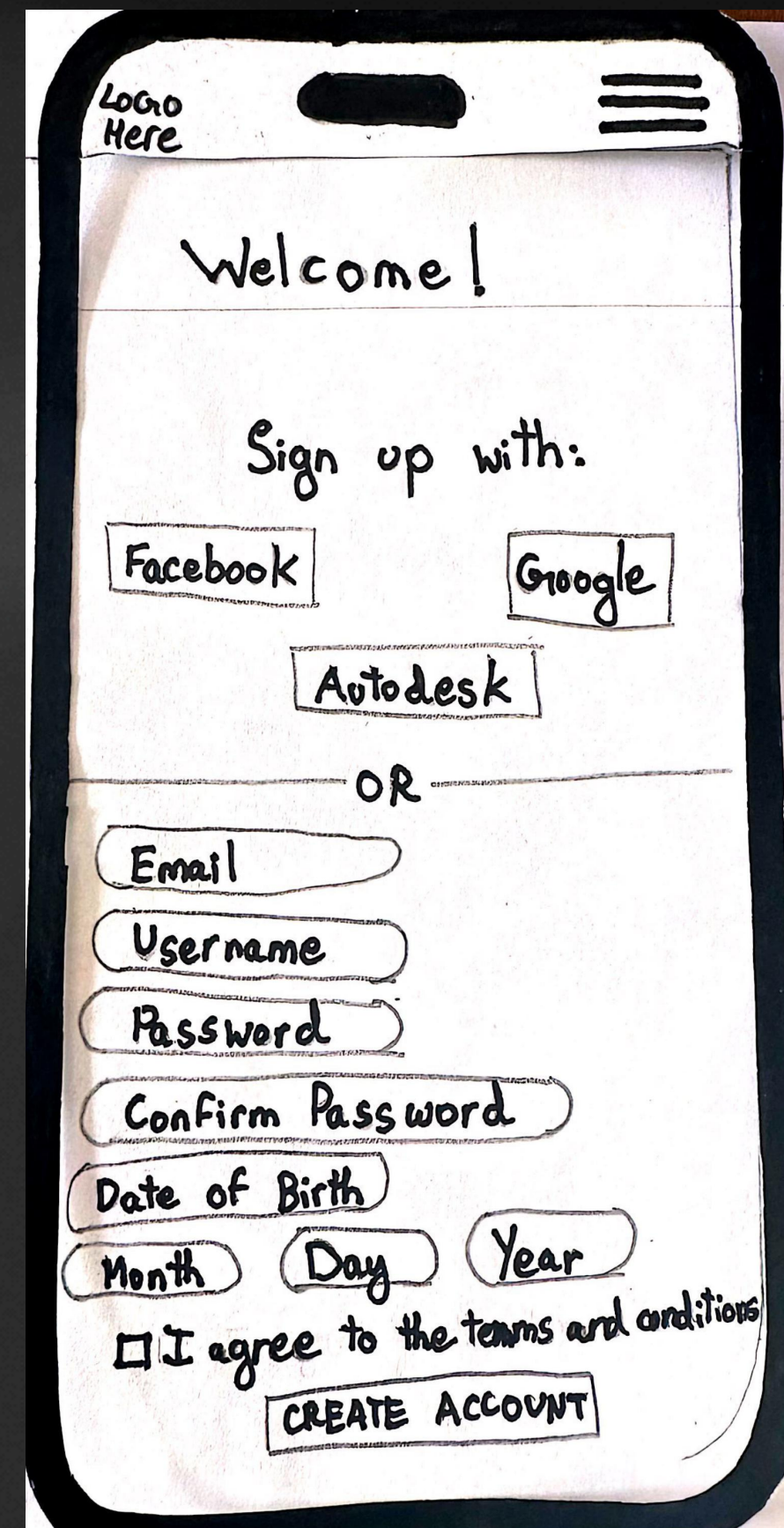
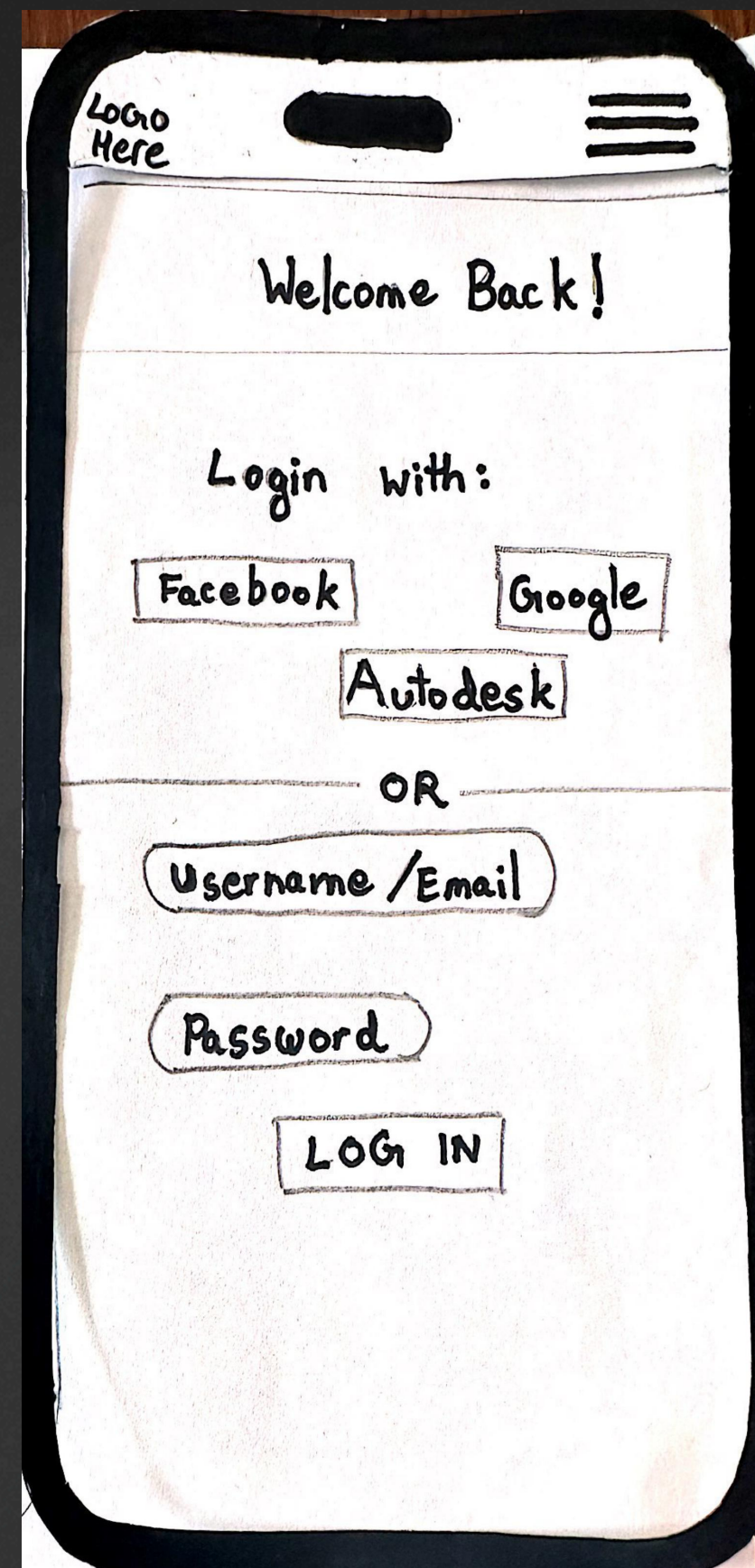
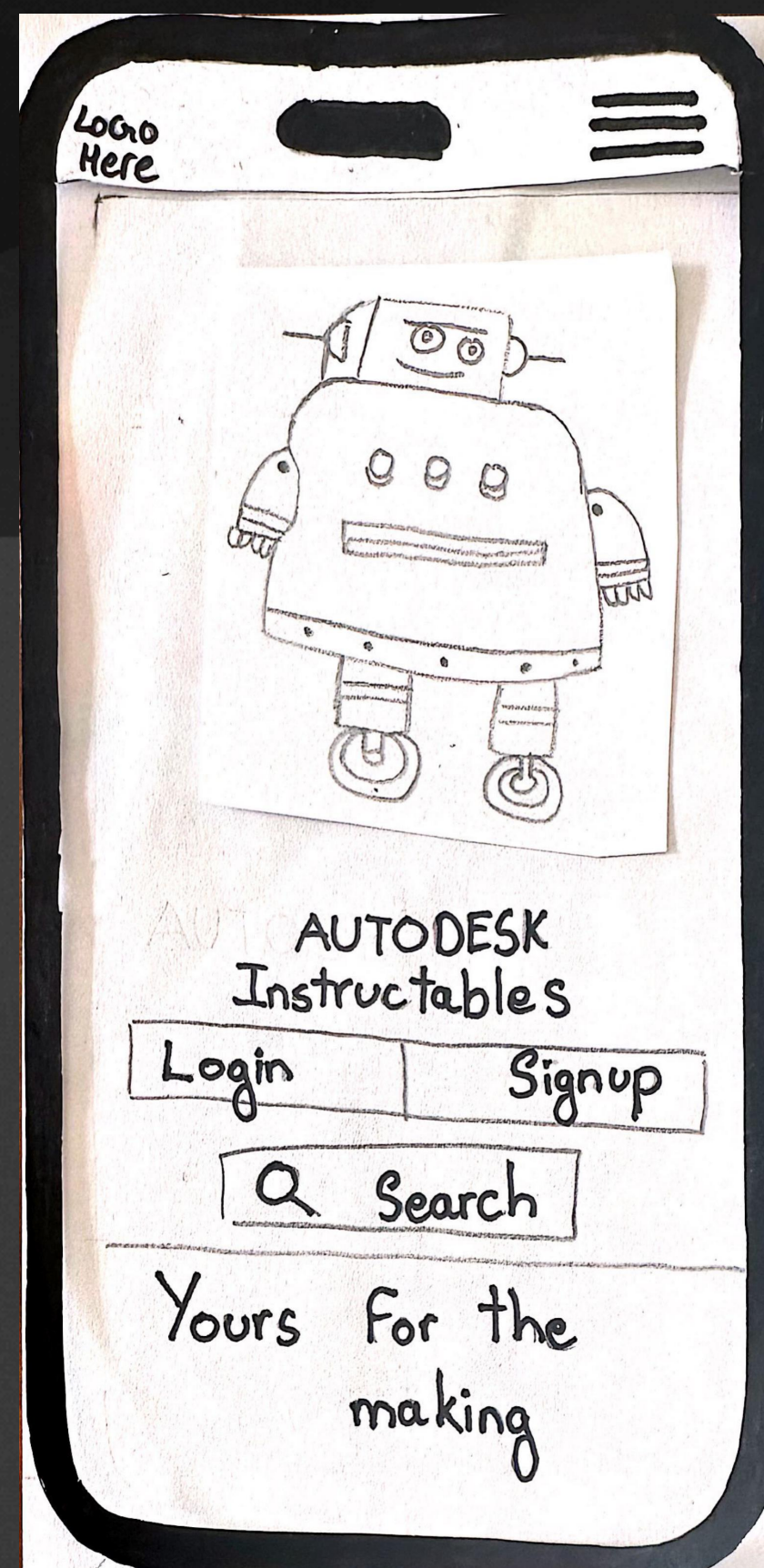
Instructables Part 2: Wireframes

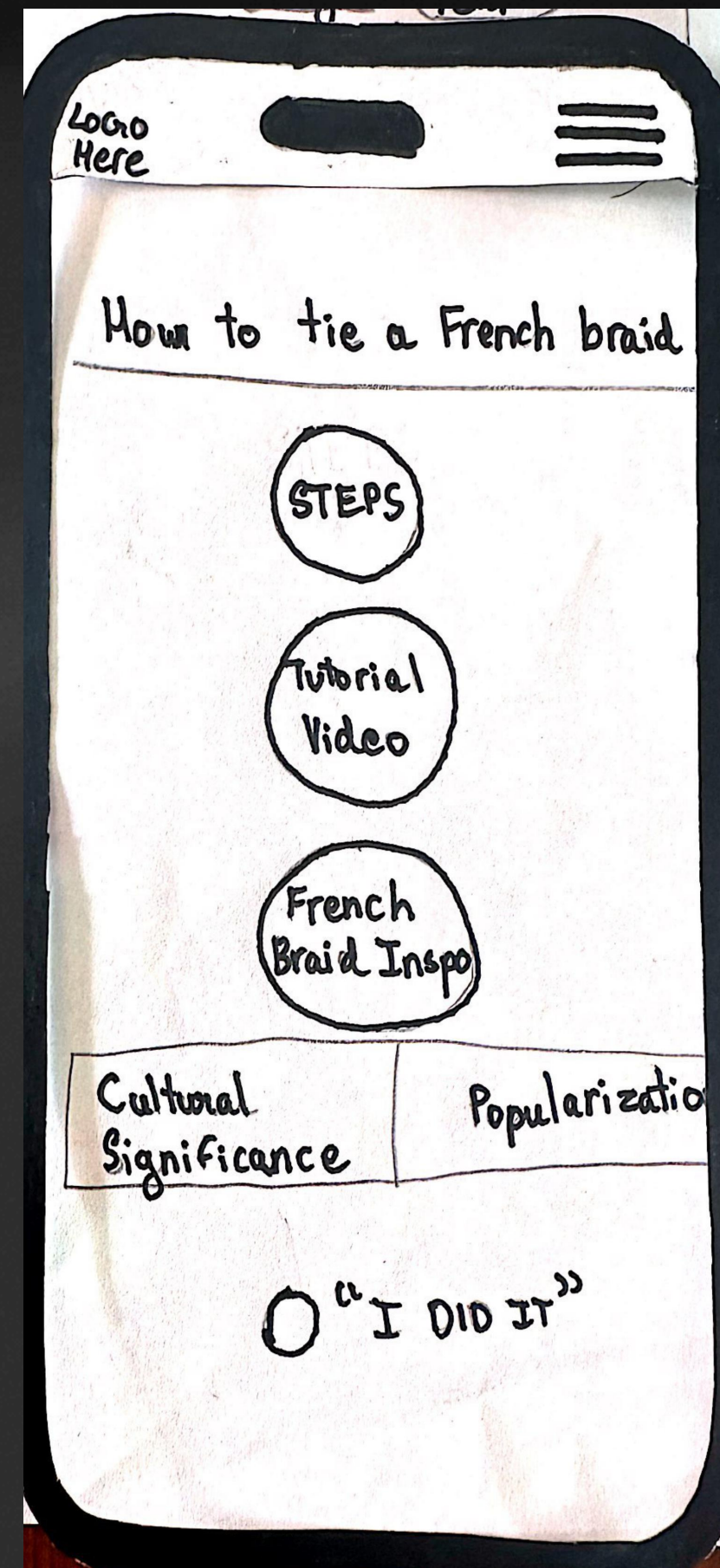
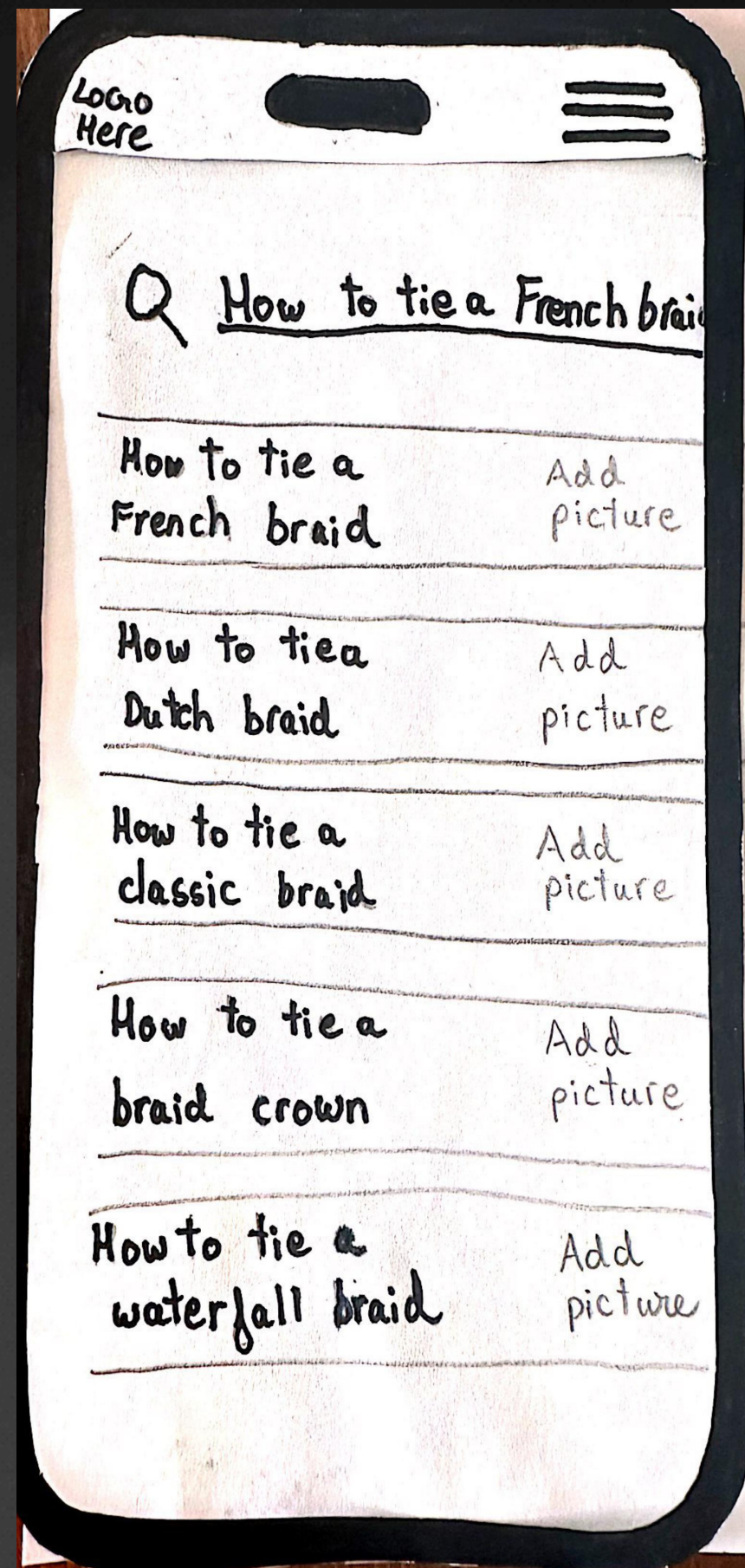
Aim of the instructable

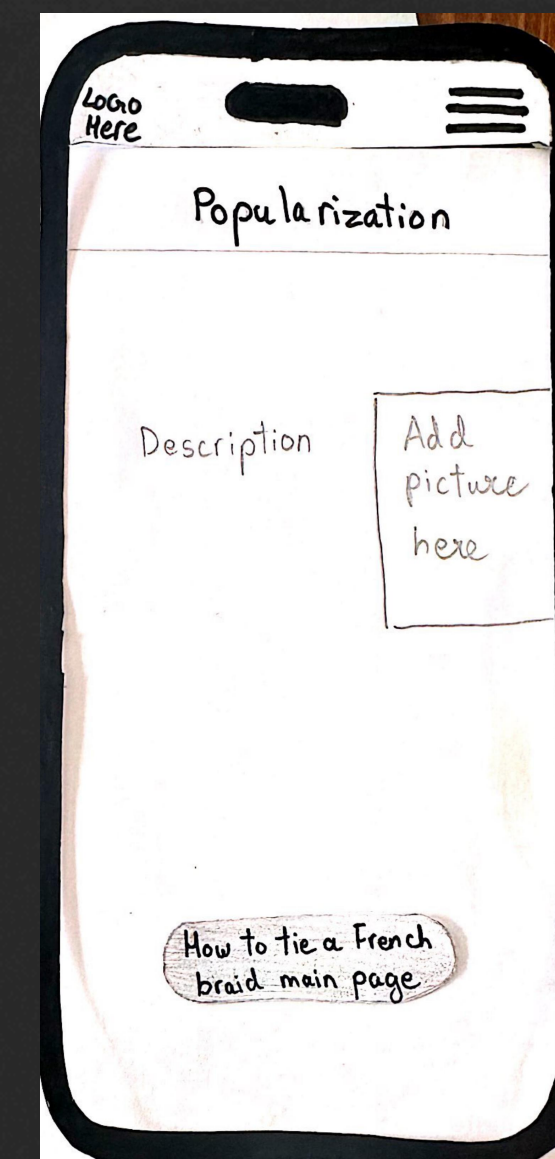
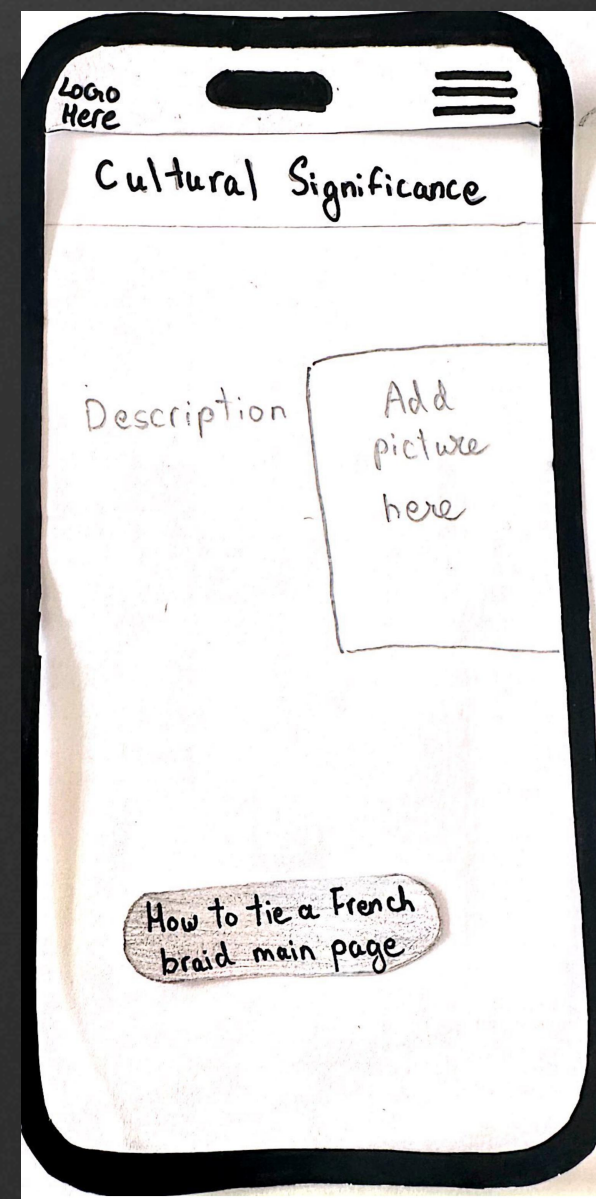
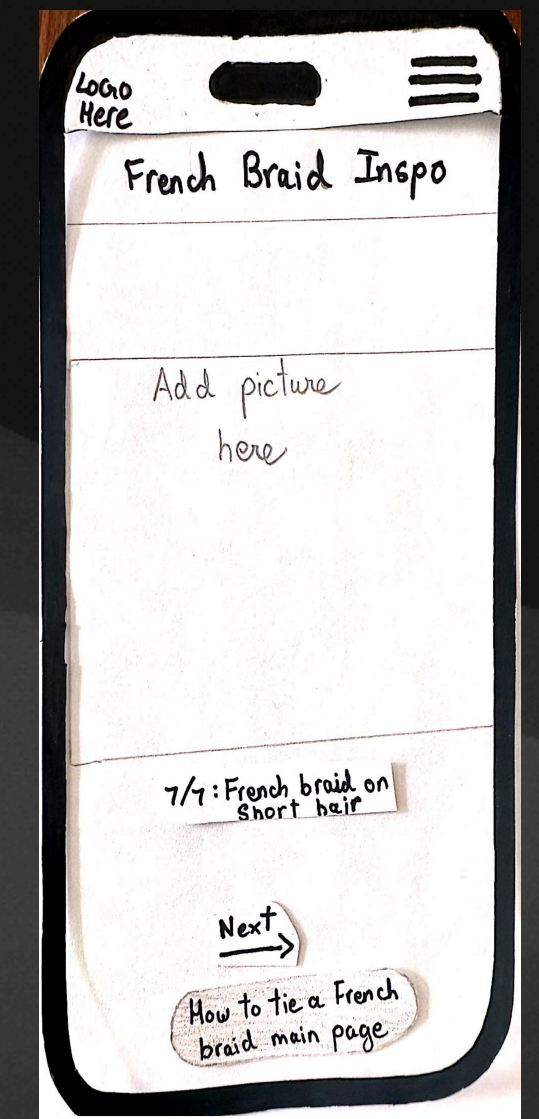
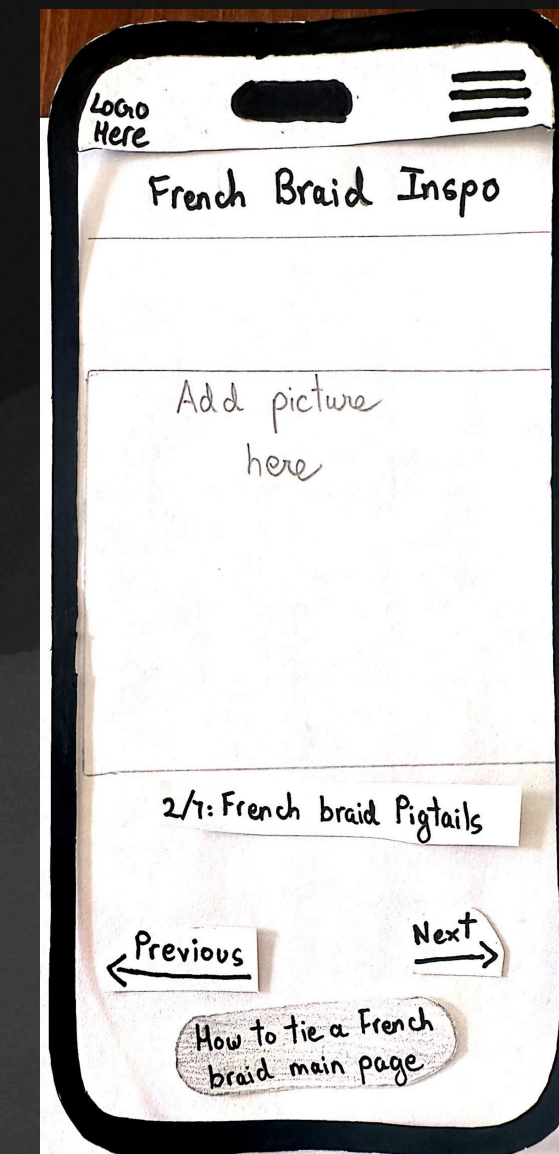
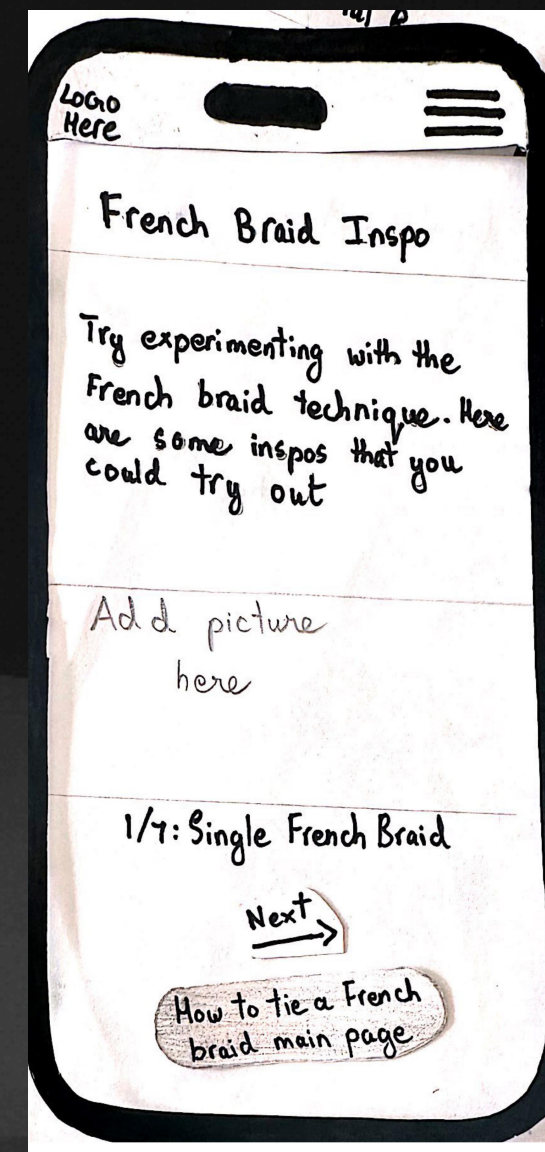
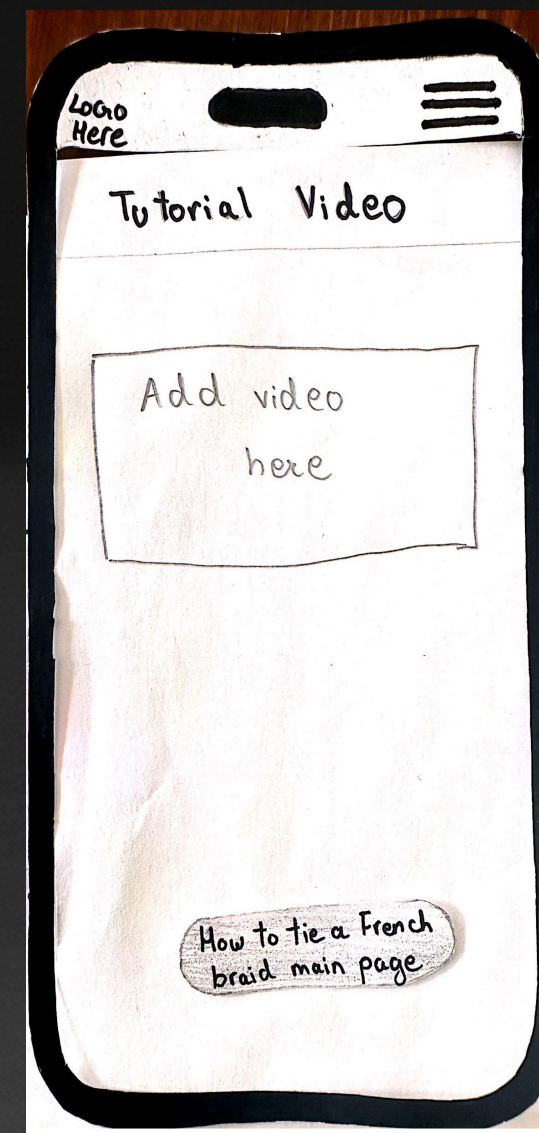
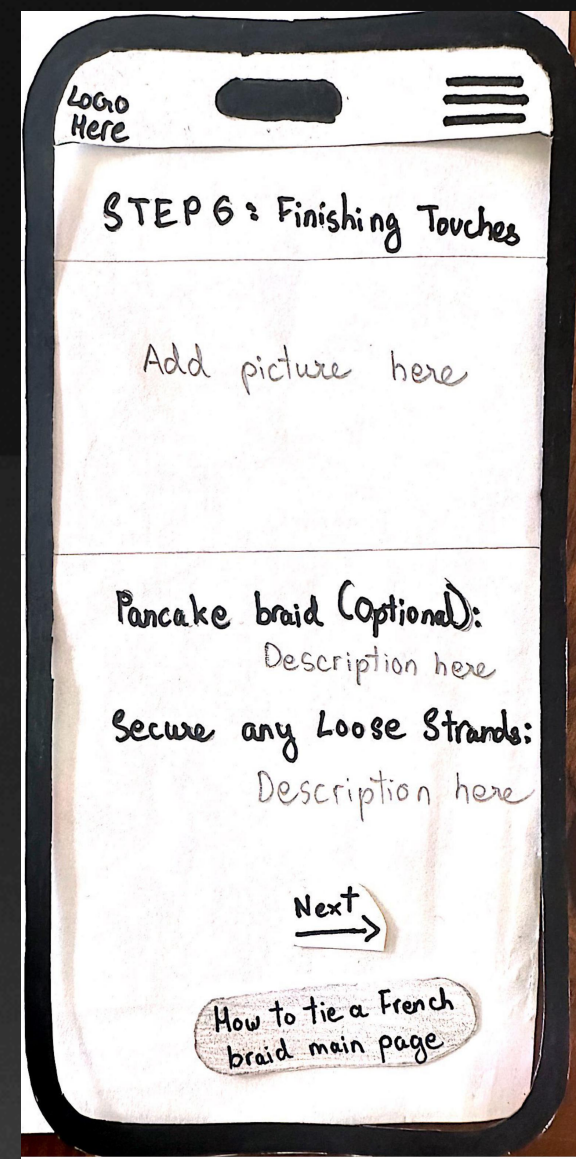
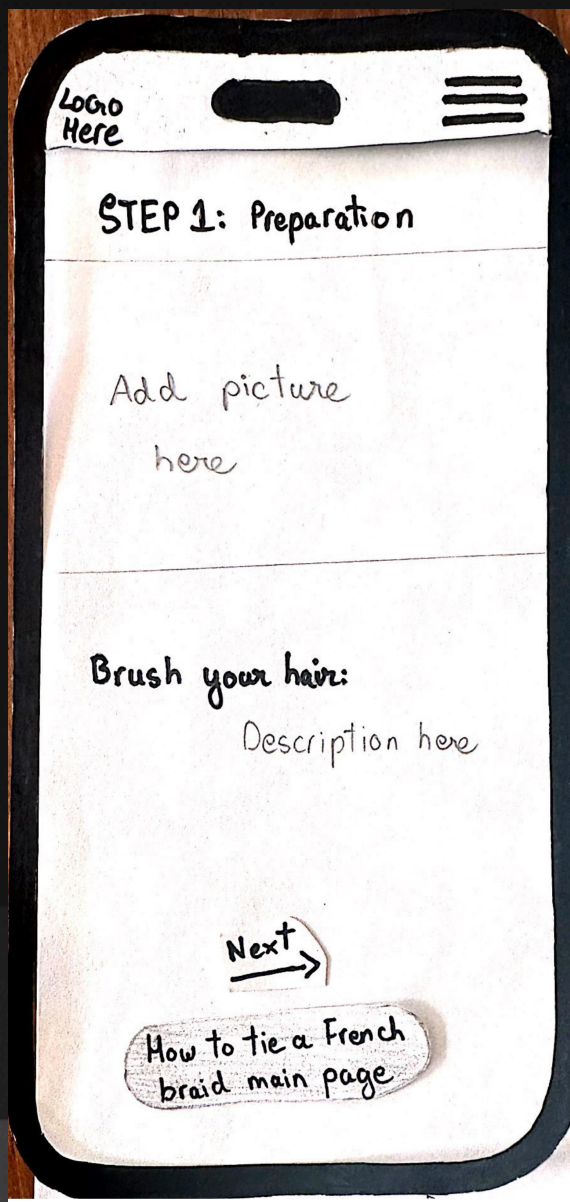
Home page, and login/Signup
